

Military Spouse Career Advancement Accounts (MyCAA)

The Department of Defense's Military Spouse Career Advancement Accounts (MyCAA) program provides **up to \$4,000 of financial assistance for military spouses** who are pursuing associate degree programs, licenses, certifications or credentials leading to employment in portable career fields.



Who is Eligible for MyCAA?

- Spouses of active duty service members in pay grades E1-E5, W1-W2, and O1-O2
- Spouses of activated Guard
- Spouses of Reserve members within those ranks*

* The MyCAA program does not include Coast Guard spouses

What does MyCAA pay for?

The MyCAA program covers tuition costs for education, training and exams leading to an Associate's degree (excluding Liberal Arts and General Studies), license, certificate or certification at an accredited education provider located within the United States.

Getting Started with MyCAA

1. Visit <https://aiportal.acc.af.mil/mycaa> and create an account
2. Choose a career path
3. Select from approved schools (Phoenix TS) and desired courses
4. Submit an Online Registration Form with your selected courses
5. Contact Military One Source at 1-800-342-9647 to speak with a MOS Education Consultant (mandatory step).
6. Your MOS Consultant will send your request for approval
7. You will be notified via email of your approval
